### 1. RULES

- a) The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- b) The engine will remain in engine well on back of the boat with ample fuel. Engine weight minimum of 60 lbs
- c) The Class Rules of the Hobie 33 Class will be in effect with the following adaptations:
  - 1) 19. Crew : The maximum crew number shall be eight. If crew change is required the same number of crew shall be used.
  - 2) 6 b. Exception for carbon tiller/tiller extensions

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- a) The Regatta is open to all One Design Hobie 33 (lift and fixed keel).
  - It is the intent of the GTYC to include as many Hobie 33s as possible if highly modified boats wish to attend they are welcome but will be scored as modified not eligible for National Trophy
- b) Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form

#### **7: SCORING**

a) Unlimited number of races are scheduled.

- b) A minimum of two completed races are required to constitute a championship.
- c) A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

## **8: HAUL IN /HAUL OUT**

- a) Boats shall be afloat by 1300 hours on August 25 and remain in water for entire regatta
- b) Lift Keel Hobie 33's shall use the ramp at Elmwood Township Marina
- c) Fixed Keel Hobie 33's may be launched and retrieved at The Harbor. Please make prior arrangements well ahead of time with Dave Darga, Harbor West Yacht Services, Inc. at 231-941-1802
- d) Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission by the Race Committee.
- e) Boats may find a slip/buoy, for the duration of the event at GTYC, or in Elmwood Township Marina, Marina Village, Clinch Park Marina.
- f) Trailers may be parked at GTYC's Bluewater Hall free of charge for the duration of the event.
- g) Arrangements can be made for longer term storage if needed. Contact GTYC's Jordan Owen. jo.gtyc@gmail.com

## **9: PRIZES**

- a) Prizes shall be awarded to the top three boats in the fleet. (Modified boats will Be scored as a separate fleet)
- b) The Hobie 33 National Championship Trophy will be awarded to the top finishing boat.
- c) The Awards Ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the last race of the regatta.

b.) Insurance – Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 (USD) per incident or the equivalent.
