1. Invitation

The Kentucky Lake Race Week Series (KLRW) is intended to promote sailing and sailboat racing in Western Kentucky. KLRW consists of several events, notably the KLSC-sponsored Watkins Cup and the CYC-sponsored Commonwealth Cup and Commonwealth Cup J/22 Regatta. The Watkins Cup is a five race series sailed round-the-buoys on the 1st weekend of KLRW. The Commonwealth Cup is a medium distance race sailed on the last weekend of KLRW. Each regatta is a stand alone event and is scored individually, however results of both regattas will be scored together to determine the

KLRW Regatta Champion. The Commonwealth Cup J/22 Regatta is a windward-leeward race series that will be scored individually.

The Notice Of Race (NOR) for the Watkins Cup, Commonwealth Cup, and Commonwealth Cup J/22 Regatta will be posted to the KLRW page on the CYC website at www.cycgtb.com. The NOR for Commonwealth Cup and Commonwealth J/22 Regatta will also be available at yachtscoring.com.

2. Eligibility and Entry

All boats entered in the KLSC Watkins Cup and the CYC Commonwealth Cup will be automatically entered into the race week series competition.

3. Classes

Eligible classes for Race Week include the following: JAM A, JAM B, Spinnaker, Cruising Class, J/22 and any other one-design class with three or more registrants.

4. Fees

No additional fees are required for the Kentucky Lake Race Week Series competition.

Note: there is a separate fee for both the Watkins Cup and the Commonwealth Cup/Commonwealth Cup J/22 Regatta.

0900 Day 2 of Watkins Cup Regatta. Trophy presentation at Lighthouse Landing immediately following race.

1700 Commonwealth Cup Registration Party and Captain's meeting at Green Turtle Bay Convention Center.

Saturday, September 30, 2017

0900 Commonwealth Cup Regatta Distance Race begins, J/22 & OD Warning signals to follow.

1800 Dinner and Awards Ceremony under the tent at Green Turtle Bay Beach

Sunday, October 1, 2017

0900 Commonwealth Cup One Design windward-leeward racing. Awards at Green Turtle Bay immediately following racing.

0900 Optional Fun Race/Colonel's Revenge as part of the CYC Sailing Series for PHRF boats. Staggered start buoy race.

6. Scoring

Scoring will be per the Racing Rules of Sailing, Appendix A. The Watkins Cup Regatta and the Commonwealth Cup Regatta will be considered one finish for purposes of calculation the winner of Kentucky Race Lake Week.

7. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the top finisher in each class.

1. Invitation

All PHRF cruising/racing boats are invited to participate in the Commonwealth Cup Regatta. The Commonwealth Cup is a distance race sailed on the last weekend of KLRW, Saturday October 3, 2015.

2. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

3. Eligibility and Entry

All boats must have a PHRF measurement form from KLSC in order to participate. Forms will be available at the captain's meeting. All boats must be registered by 1900 Friday, October 3, 2015.

4. Fees

Registration fee for the Commonwealth Cup and the Commonwealth Cup One Design together is \$70.
