

## Florida State Championship Series/Green Bench Regatta

# April 1-2, 2017 St. Petersburg, FL NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. Rules:

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority and host is the St. Petersburg Yacht Club.
- 1.2. The regatta is a J/24 Class Association sanctioned event in conjunction with the local J/24 Fleet #169.
- 1.3. The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing and the current International J/24 Class Rules except as changed by the Sailing Instructions. US Sailing Prescriptions for rules 60.3, 63.2, and 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.4. The Green Bench Regatta is part of the Florida State Series.

## 2. Eligibility & Entry:

- 2.1. Competitors (Owners and Helmsmen) must meet all ownership and J/24 Class Association membership requirements in order to be eligible for Florida State Series scoring and must complete all aspects of the registration process. Class membership is not mandatory in order to compete solely in the Green Bench Regatta. All boats/crews must conform to current class requirements and be available for spot check if necessary.
- 2.2. This is an advance registration event. Entry may be completed online by using the link found at www.spyc.org or www.yachtscoring.com
- 2.3 6 registered boats are necessary for a regatta.

#### 3. Fees:

- 3.1. The entry fee is \$100 per boat, which includes launching (Hoist), 2 days of racing, and beverages on Saturday after racing.
- 3.2. Online entry will close at 1700 Thursday March 30, 2017.

### 5. Sailing Instructions:

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and at <a href="https://www.yachtscoring.com">www.yachtscoring.com</a> no later than 1600 hrs on Friday March 31st.

### 6. Inspection & Measurement:

6.1 The regatta shall abide by the J/24 class rules of sailing with the following modifications. Rule 2.5.1, measurement certificate will not be required to race.

## 7. Racing Area:

7.1 The racing area will be Tampa Bay, Florida, East of the Municipal Marina.

### 8. Scoring:

- 8.1 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.1
- 8.2 When five or more races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.1

#### 9. Awards:

9.1. Prizes will be awarded for the top 3 boats finishing the regatta.

## 11. Launching and Rafting:

- 11.1. All yachts will be wet sailed during the regatta and shall be launched by 1200 hrs on Saturday April 1st. For the purposes of launching, a hoist is available at the St. Petersburg Sailing Center.
- 11.2 **SPSC Rules** require sailors and/or coaches to make special arrangements with the waterfront director Shawn Macking, 727-822-3113 or via e-mail <u>waterfront-director@spyc.org</u> for loading and unloading, parking and loading trailers. Vehicles, trailers and boats left at the SPSC more than 48 hours after the end of an event may be towed at owner's expense unless prior arrangements have been made. - 11.3 Competitors who are not members of SPYC or SPSC must sign a Sailing Center Liability Waiver Agreement for hoisting and retrieving.
