AMENDED NOTICE OF RACE

INVITATION

The Kelowna Yacht Club is pleased to host the annual Commodore's Cup Regatta. All activities will be concentrated around the Kelowna Yacht Club, starting with registration on Friday event and various social events over the weekend including live music and dancing. The Regatta Committee invites all skippers, their crews and supporters and sponsors to enjoy the on-shore festivities.

RULES

The races will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing [2017-2020], the prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and Class Rules where they apply together with any other applicable rules. All boats will be issued a fleet pennant that MUST be flown when racing.

SPONSORSHIP

Any advertising on boats will be allowed as long as it meets ISAF Regulation 20, as stated in The Rules of Sailing.

ELIGIBILITY

The Commodore's Cup Regatta is open to all boats of the Santana 525 Class that meet the obligations of the Class Rules, and all keelboats having a current PHRF certificate. Any boat not holding a valid B.C. Sailing PHRF Certificate will be issued a rating by the Commodore's Cup Race Committee.

REGISTRATION

We strongly recommend that all skippers, crew and guests register on-line for racing, reciprocal moorage as well as meal tickets at www.kelownayachtclub.com. Regular registration is available at the Kelowna Yacht Club clubhouse on Friday, August 18, 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and on Saturday, August 19, 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. If you are unable to attend during these times, please contact the office at: 250-762-3310 to coordinate pickup or mailing of your package.

RACING

The Race Committee will start races on Saturday at 10:00 a.m. & on Sunday at 9:30 a.m. No race will start later than 4:00 pm on Saturday and 2pm on Sunday.

FLEETS

The Race Committee will decide fleet divisions after the number and type of entrants is determined. All boats entering a spinnaker class will be rated as a spinnaker equipped boat, regardless of whether they fly a spinnaker or not.

Spinnaker Fleets three fleets are anticipated

White Sail Boats will be required to sail in the regular spinnaker fleet

SCORING

Scoring will be in accordance with The Racing Rules of Sailing 90.3 and Appendix A, using the low point system [appendix A4.1] and will be calculated by time on time.

PRIZES

Trophies and prizes will be awarded at the Kelowna Yacht Club reception on Sunday the 20th of August at 3:00 p.m. (or earlier as racing permits).

Keelboat prizes

- Keelboat prizes for will be awarded in each fleet.
- One (1) overall Keelboat prize will be awarded for the combined fleets.

Santana 525 National prize

- The Santana 525 National Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of the Santana 525 race.

MOORAGE

Please complete that portion of the application on your online registration or complete the <u>Reciprocal Moorage</u> request form. Temporary key cards can be obtained at the office with a \$20 refundable deposit or upon arrival at registration table on Friday evening or Saturday morning.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee is \$80.00 + GST + \$13 Admin Fee per boat if registration is completed online before **Friday**, **August 4**

Or \$100.00 + GST + \$13 Admin Fee if registered after that time. Your fees include:

- 1. Two great days of racing
- 2. Friday & Saturday evening of live entertainment
- 3. Fleet and crew prizes for each fleet

Tickets for boxed lunches are available for all sailors and supporters on the online registration as well as through the office of Kelowna Yacht Club.

Refunds/Cancellations will be accepted up to 72 hours prior to the start of the Regatta weekend (5pm on Friday, August 18, 2017) with a full refund less the Admin Fee. No refunds/cancellations will be processed after that time.
