NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules:

- 11 The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (current) and the prescriptions of the Yacht Racing Association of Long Island Sound (YRALIS), except as any of these are changed by the sailing instructions.

2 Eligibility

- 21 Open to single-hull yachts whose owner is a member of the YRALIS or recognized yacht club or association affiliated with the US Sailing Association. The race will be managed by the Race Committee of the Port Washington Yacht Club.
- 22 All PHRF boats must submit with the application a current YRALIS PHRF certificate. The fleet shall be divided into classes according to a yacht's PHRF or IRC rating at the discretion of the Race Committee. A special non-spinnaker class will be included for auxiliary boats.
- 2.4 Designation as a non-spinnaker yacht must be made by the yacht owner or skipper by the registration deadline on Friday Oct 6, 2017 at 5p.m.
- 2.5 Designation as an Ideal 18 boat must be made by the skipper by the registration deadline on Friday Oct 6, 2017 at 5 pm.
- 2.6 Designation as a Laser Radial boat must be made by the skipper by the registration deadline on Friday Oct 6, 2017 at 5 pm.
- 2.7 Ideal 18 division is Non-Spinnaker only.

3. Entry Fees

- 31 PHRF Boats: \$75.00 (Included is a BBQ for skipper plus 8 crew members after the race). Additional wristbands for the BBQ can be purchased for \$10.00 each.
- 32 Ideal 18 boats and Lasers: \$50.00 (Included is a BBQ for skipper.) Additional wrist bands for the BBQ can be purchased for \$10.00 each.
- 33 Entries will not be accepted after 5:00 PM, Friday October 6, 2017.
- 34 Registration at YachtScoring, www.yachtscoring.com.

4. Schedule

- 41 **PHRF:** A pre-warning signal for the first division will sound approximately at 11:50 am. The first warning signal will be at 1155 on Saturday, Oct. 7, 2017.
- 42 **Ideal 18s:** A pre-warning signal for Ideal 18 is approximately 1355 on Saturday, Oct 7th 2017. Lasers shall follow Ideal 18's.

5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions for both the PHRF boats and the Ideal 18s will be available on YachtScoring and at Port Washington YC before the race. The SI for Ideal 18 will be the 2017 Sailing Instructions, YRALIS-Cow Bay Racing One-Design Committee.

6. Radio Communication

- 61 Official announcements by the Race Committee on VHF channel 74 will supersede the sailing instructions.

7. Prizes/Awards BBQ

- 71 First place prizes will be awarded in each division. Second place prizes will be awarded for divisions with five starters. Third place will be awarded for divisions with 8 starters. Overall winner, as determined by the Race Committee.
- 72 Race results will be announced following the race at the PWYC no earlier than 2 p.m. and ending at 7 p.m. Prizes will be awarded at a BBQ at the PWYC immediately following the race. Soft drinks and a keg of beer will be provided for sailors. A cash bar will be available for those who choose other beverages.

8. Launch Service

- 81 Contact the PWYC dock facilities at VHF ch. 74 or tel. (516) 767-1614, ext. 29 for mooring instructions and launch service.

9. Disclaimer of Liability

- 91 Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Port Washington Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damages or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Rule 4: Decision To Race – The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.
