- 3. ELIGIBILITY: The regatta is open to boats of the International Snipe Class and the Windmill Class.

6. VENUE: Boats may be launched from SPSC on Demen's Landing, 250 2nd Avenue SE. The racing area will be on Tampa Bay east of downtown.

7. COURSES: The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing

Instructions.

8. SCORING:

8.1 The Low Point Scoring System of *RRS* Appendix A will be used.

8.2 One race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

8.3 There will be a throw out if five or more races are completed.

9. PRIZES:
