1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. Appendix E will apply.
 - 1.2.1. E2.2 is deleted.
 - 1.2.2. E4.4 is changed "competitor" is change to competitors".
 - 1.2.3. G1.3 (a) is deleted.
 - 1.2.4. G1.4 is deleted.
 - 1.2.5. G1.5 is changed to "Sail numbers should be placed on the Starboard side of the sail; race committee can require a boat to adjust numbers for visibility".
 - 1.2.6. G1.6 is deleted.

2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the sliding door which is the entrance to the Sailing School classroom.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1200 on the day it will take effect. Verbal changes to the sailing instructions will be allowed and may take place in between races with the intention of keeping the sailing fun and fair.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be verbal and announced by the RC for that race or regatta chair.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1. Sunday, November 19, 2017

- 5.2. Number of races will not exceed 25.
- 5.3. Depending on conditions RC and the Regatta Chair may decide to include breaks throughout the day for competitors to warm up, use restrooms, and fill drinks.

6. RACING AREA

The racing area will be in Monroe Harbor, south of the Columbia Yacht Club ship and east of the dock.

7. THE COURSE

The course will be discussed before the first race, and before the start of the next race if it has been changed. Courses will change to best suit area and conditions.

8. MARKS

Marks will be orange buoys.

9. THE START

Appendix U will be used.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1. A One-Turn Penalty will be in place for a Part 2 violation. No penalty shall be taken for a Rule 31 violation.
- 10.2. This changes Appendix E Rule E7.

11. PRIZES

1st-5th will be awarded at the end of the day.
