1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. Appendix E will apply.
 - 1.2.1. E2.2 is deleted.
 - 1.2.2. E4.4 is changed “competitor” is change to competitors”.
 - 1.2.3. G1.3 (a) is deleted.
 - 1.2.4. G1.4 is deleted.
 - 1.2.5. G1.5 is changed to “Sail numbers should be visible on both sides of the sail; race committee can require a boat to adjust numbers for visibility”.
 - 1.2.6. G1.6 is deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to the Dragon Force 65 class.
- 2.2. Boats must use the standard “A” rig to compete.
- 2.3. Eligible boats will enter at yachtscoring.com.
- 2.4. Late entries will be accepted if they donate a minimum of \$5 to the Columbia Sailing School, or the Sailing School of their choice.

3. FEES

The cost to enter is \$10, which include awards and the cost of the scoring program used.
