SUPPLEMENT to the STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTION (Numbering corresponds to the RRS Appendix S)

[DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the protest committee.

[NP] denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for protest by a boat.

1.2 RULES

In case of a conflict between the Notice of Race, the Standard Sailing Instructions or Supplementary Sailing Instructions will prevail. This changes Rule 63.7.


7 THE COURSE

7.1 Only the course shown in this supplement will be used for the event and as such no course designation will be posted; no later than the warning signal, the race committee will display the approximate compass bearing and distance of the first leg.

7.3 Rounding order: Start – 1 (port) – 1a (port) – 2s/2p (gate) – 1 (port) – 1a (port) – Finish

7.4 If mark 1a is not present, it will be omitted from the rounding order.

7.5 If either of mark 2s/2p are missing, the remaining mark will be rounded to port.

9 THE START

9.3 Initial Starting Sequence

^{9.4} Starting sequence in the second and subsequent races of each day may vary.

9.5 The Race Committee may announce the sail number or boat name of each premature starter on the applicable VHF channel. Failure to make an announcement or the order in which boats are announced shall not be grounds for redress. This changes Rule 62.1(a).

11.2 THE FINISH

The Race Committee may, at its discretion, award points to a boat, equivalent to the boat's position in the race. The Race Committee determines the method and order. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

12 TIME LIMITS

12.4 Boats failing to start within the start window will be scored DNS. This changes Rule A5.

To Start – 4 minutes

To Mark 1 – 30 minutes

Race Target time – 60 minutes

Race time limit - 120 minutes

Finish window - 20 minutes

13 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

13.1 The protest desk will be located in the Chartroom on the main floor of the NYC clubhouse. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there within the appropriate time limit.

- 13.2 Is changed to "The protest time limit is 60 minutes after the docking of the signal boat at the end of each day".
- 13.6 Appendix T Arbitration will apply to this event.

14 PENALTY SYSTEM

There will be no changes to Rule 44.1.

15 SCORING

- 14.1. One race is required to be complete to constitute a series.
- 14.2. A boat's score will be the total of her races score. This changes Rule A2.1.

16 SAFETY

- 15.1 Boats shall check in with the race committee prior to their first race of the day by sailing past the transom of the committee boat. [DP]
- 15.2 Boats shall advise the race committee if leaving the race area prior to the end of the last day of the day. [DP]
