

SAUGATUCK HARBOR YACHT CLUB Saugatuck Harbor Cup Double Handed Race

Notice of Race

Saturday, Sept 1, 2018

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Saugatuck Harbor Yacht Club Saugatuck Harbor Cup Double Handed Race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020 except as modified by this Notice of Race or by the Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto and by the PHRF Regulations of the Yacht Racing Association of Long Island Sound
- 1.2. If there is any conflict between any rule and a rule in the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions and any amendments shall take precedence.
- 1.3. The Organizing Authority is the Saugatuck Harbor Yacht Club.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to boats holding a current YRALIS PHRF Rating Certificate
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the process on the event page on <u>https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=4596</u> by 1800 on Monday August 27th.
- 2.3. Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Entry Fee X 2 until 1200 on Thursday, August 30th.
- 2.4. Entrants are required to have a female skipper on the helm from the preparatory signal until the boat has finished, except for brief breaks by the helmsperson for necessities. Boats must compete with a maximum of two crew members including the helmsperson.

3. FEES

3.1. The entry fee will be \$125. Entry fee includes a slip at Saugatuck Harbor Yacht Club on Friday, August 31st. Saturday, Sept 1 includes a slip and an Awards Dinner in the evening, on a first come basis. Crews may bring dinner guests for an additional charge of \$35 per person.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. Racing is scheduled for Saturday, Sept 1st with the first warning signal at 1100. One race will be sailed.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on Yachtscoring.com after 1200 on August 6th .

6. DIVISIONS

6.1. Racing will be conducted into divisions by PHRF Rating. The Race Committee at its discretion, may combine Divisions or adjust division splits depending on the number of competitors entered. All Divisions will be non-spinnaker.

7. VENUE

7.1 Racing will be conducted on the waters of Long Island Sound. The starting line will be in the vicinity of Red Bell R24 off Westport CT.

8. PRIZES

8.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each division.

9. BERTHING

9.1 Visiting boats may inquire with the Club Manager, Tim Merullo to make slip reservations by calling 203-227-3607

10. LIABILITY

10.1 Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race.
