

DESIGNER AWARDS

These awards honor the sailors and the legendary individuals who designed the boats they competed on in the regatta. To the yachts, according to the race organizers, which were most successful among those from their respective designers:

Sparkman & Stephens and the winner of the Mitch Gibbons Neff Cup, in memory of Mitch Gibbons Neff, former president of S & S Inc.

SPECIALTY AWARDS

Atlantic Trophy – awarded to the best overall elapsed time by a Classic yacht, the Atlantic Trophy was originally awarded by King Alfonso XIV of Spain to the schooner Atlantic for her performance in the 1928 Trans-Atlantic race from Sandy Hook to Santander, Spain

Sappho Trophy – awarded to the best overall corrected time by a Classic yacht, the Sappho Trophy dates back to 1871 when it was awarded to the schooner Sappho in the Cape May Regatta

Leiter Cup – awarded to the best overall corrected time by a gaff rigged, classic, non-spinnaker yacht, the Leiter Cup was originally won by the brigantine Black Pearl in 1962.

Candy Cup – awarded to the 12 Meter with the best record in the fleet, in honor of Candy Isdale for her passion and participation in all things yachting

Tom Benson Restoration Award – awarded to the best restored yacht; based on degree of originality and quality of restoration done within the past two years, in honor of Tom Benson, co-founder of the Newport Classic Yacht Regatta

Clingstone Cannon – awarded to the individual or individuals, according to the race organizers, with the best Corinthian Spirit, the Clingstone Cannon was donated by the Wharton Family in memory of those loved ones who had their lives enriched by the experience of yachting on Narragansett Bay
