Rules: The races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

Eligibility: The regatta is open to Class C Scows. Helms-persons MUST be Regular Members of the NCSSA. Eligible yachts may be entered by completing registration with the Association.

Advertising: The regatta is designated as a Category A event in accordance with the ISAF Regulation 20.

Registration : [Yachtscoring.com](#) will be used for the regatta registration. You can enter without paying. Please enter early to help the numbers and encourage others. Payment is due prior to May 15<sup>th</sup> to complete registration and avoid late fees.

Lunch and Awards after completion of the final race.

- Scoring: The low point scoring system, RRS A4, shall apply. Six races are scheduled, of which three must be completed to constitute a series. A boat's worst score will be discarded if all six races are completed. This changes RRS A2.
- Prizes: NCSSA perpetual trophies will be awarded as per the class requirements. Series prizes will be awarded to the skipper and two crew finishing 1 through 10. Skippers for the Master, and Junior division winners will receive prizes.
