# **Eligibility**

### J/24

This competition is open to all J/24 Class yachts as defined by the International J/24 Class Association. Helmsmen must be members of the International J/24 Class Association. All competing boats must complete online race registration and pay all required fees prior to racing, submit a valid Measurement Certificate, liability waiver signed by the skipper and each crew member, and evidence of minimum \$300K liability insurance during the registration process.

#### **PHRF**

The yacht owner or designated representative must use the DYC website, <a href="www.duluthyachtclub.com">www.duluthyachtclub.com</a> or <a href="yachtscoring.com">yachtscoring.com</a> to complete online race registration and pay all required fees prior to racing. Additionally, in order to race, the yacht must have a current PHRF rating from the DYC Ratings Committee or be in compliance with applicable one-design class rules if racing in a one-design class. Prior to racing, all yachts must obtain and provide proof of insurance to the Race Committee showing adequate liability insurance in full force and effect during racing which shall include a general liability policy written by a responsible insurance company insuring the owner and any operators against liability for bodily injury. Yachts must have on board one member in good standing with a recognized yacht club affiliated with US Sailing or ISAF.

## One Design

This competition is also open to any one design class with 5 or more registered boats, they will be granted their own start. The yacht owner or designated representative must use the DYC website, www.duluthyachtclub.com, to complete online race registration and pay all required fees prior to racing. Additionally, in order to race, the yacht must be in compliance with applicable one-design class rules if racing in a one-design class. Prior to racing, all yachts must obtain and provide proof of insurance to the Race Committee showing adequate liability insurance in full force and effect during racing which shall include a general liability policy

written by a responsible insurance company insuring the owner and any operators against liability for bodily injury. Yachts must have on board one member in good standing with a recognized yacht club affiliated with US Sailing or ISAF.

#### **Fun Sail**

This regatta will be offering a "Fun Sail" in which we invite all sailors not interested in racing, but would like to partake in this great event. The "Fun Sail" will take place on Saturday August 4th. Prior to participating, all yachts must obtain and provide proof of insurance to the Race Committee showing adequate liability insurance in full force and effect during their participation which shall include a general liability policy written by a responsible insurance company insuring the owner and any operators against liability for bodily injury.

## Rules

## J/24

This regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, the Class Rules of the International J/24 Class Association (IJCA), and this Notice of Race, except that any of these may be altered by the Sailing Instructions. A jury appointed by the organizing authority will hear protests and request for redress.

#### **PHRF**

Racing will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Sailing Instructions except as altered in the Sailing Instructions or as announced on VHF 72 and/or as posted on the DYC website. The race committee is not obligated to post changes to notices on the website.
