Tri-State Leg 3 Michigan City to Chicago Special Sailing Instructions

1. CLASS BREAKS & STARTING TIMES

2. THE COURSE

The distance of the course is 29.6 NM. Approximately 286° T

2.1. STARTING LINE

Between an orange tetra and the orange flag on the RC boat. If a guard mark is set near RC boat; yachts may not pass between the guard mark and RC boat.

3. THE FINISH

When approximately one mile from the finish, each boat shall notify the race committee on Channel 78. Sail number boards shall be displayed on the Starboard side at the finish.

3.1. Boats shall cross the line between the white mark and blue line flag on RC boat.

3.2 Whenever a RC boat is not on station at the finish line, finishing yachts shall follow the procedure outlined in the US Sailing prescription to RRS 34 as modified. The last sentence of the US Sailing prescription to RRS 34 is modified to read:
If a boat finishes when race committee is absent, to be scored as finishing she shall
1. Note her finishing time. The finish time shall be the GPS CDT time when the alternate finish line is crossed

 Notify the RC, on Channel 78, of their finish time (GPS CDT time) as soon as practical after finishing". If no response, call: Janet Hansen at 773-233-5520
 If no response, text information to 773-233-5520 no later than 2030 09/03/2018.
 if there is no longer an established finish line, it shall be a line of Longitude bounded by two lines of Latitude as follows: Longitude - W 087 ° 32.37, Latitude - N 41 ° 51.84 and N 41 ° 51.94. The finish time shall be the GPS time shown when the finish line is crossed.

4. TIME LIMIT

The time limit shall be 2000 hours CDT 9/3/2018 plus the amount of any postponement time applicable to a yacht's class. This changes RRS 35.
