# Barrington Yacht Club <br> 2018 Two Person Races <br> June 20, 2018 and September 12, 2018 Notice of Race and Entry Form 

1. Rules: The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. Entries and eligibility:
2.1. The race is open to all mono-hull sailboats
2.2. Boats must have a 2018 PHRF-NB rating certificate,
2.3. Crew size is limited to two individuals, including skipper.
2.4. This is a non-spinnaker race.
2.5. Use of autopilots or other auxiliary means of steering or propulsion is prohibited.
2.6. The entry form and waiver on Yachtscoring.com shall be completed by 1700 hours on June 19, 2018, for the June race. And by 1700 hours on September 11, 2018 for the September race.
3. .Fees:
3.1. The entry fee is $\$ 30.00$ for each race or $\$ 50.00$ for both the June and Septmeber races. Additional $\$ 10.00$ fee for non-members.
3.2. Club charge will be made available or pay through online PayPal also accepted.
4. Schedule:
4.1. First Warning Signal
4.1.1. 1830 hours.
4.1.2. If there is more than one class, the starting order and class flags will be described in the scratch sheet to be available NLT 1500 on the day of each race.
5. Sailing Instructions: The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Club's Race Notice Board and available on the event web site no less than 48 hours prior to each race.

## 6. Courses:

6.1. The race committee will select a course using individual mark letters from Appendix A of the 2018 Tuesday night Cox Series.
6.2. Mark letters shall be posted in the order in which marks are to be rounded.
6.3. The race committee may, as a courtesy, broadcast the courses on VHF channel 72. A boat shall have no right to redress concerning the broadcast of courtesy information or lack or timeliness of same.
7. Penalty System: The penalty system in Rule 44.1 as modified by Rule V1,
8. Scoring:
8.1. Scoring will be in accordance with Appendix A
8.2. There will be one race in June and August.
8.2.1. The two races are not related with regards to scoring.
8.3. The corrected time for each boat, adjusted for PHRF time-on-distance, shall determine her finishing score.
8.4. There may be multiple classes in this race, depending on entries received.
9. Prizes
9.1. Prizes will be awarded for the top two OR three finishers, depending upon fleet size.
9.2. If there is more than one class, the top three finishers in each class will receive awards.
