NOTICE OF REGATTA

1. Rules: This regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* for 2017-2020, the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, and the rules of the United States Albacore Association, except as any of these are altered by this notice, and by the sailing instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry: All boats must be helmed by a full or associate member of the United States Albacore Association or any other national Albacore Association.

3. Number and Schedule of Races: Several races may be sailed on any day at the discretion of the race committee

(no upper limit). The warning signal for the first race each day scheduled as indicated below: Sat. Oct. 6th 1030 Skippers Meeting: 1200 Warning Signal for Race 1, other races to follow

Sun. Oct. 7th 1100 Warning Signal for 1st race of the day, other races to follow.

Mon. Oct. 8th 1000 Warning Signal for 1st race of the day, other races to follow.

Awards immediately following racing on Monday. No warning signal after 1400 on Monday October 8th.

4. Social and Registration Schedule

Fri. Oct. 5th 1700 – 2000 Check-in, Late Registration, and Measurements at RBSA Sat. Oct. 6th 0830 – 1000 Check-in, Late Registration, and Measurements at RBSA Sat. Oct. 6th 1800 Pizza Dinner per invitation of USAA for all registered participants. Extra tickets for guests required (\$15.00) Sun. Oct. 7th 1900 Dinner @ Crabby Dicks Restaurant (Rehoboth location) Tickets for registered participants included in Registration Extra tickets (\$25.00) available with registration.

5. Launching: Beach launching or one 3 point crane

6. Advance Registration: Sailors should register in advance by completing the online registration form at <u>Albacore North Americans Registration</u> on YachtScoring. Select your Tee shirt sizes (Small, Medium, Large, Extra Large) also on YachtScoring.

8. Measurement: All boats must be accompanied by a valid measurement certificate with a current buoyancy endorsement. All boats must comply with the rules and regulations for this event.

No provision will be made for issuing new measurement certificates or endorsements at the regatta.

All measurement must be complete in advance of the event.

9. Safety Equipment: Each boat must carry safety equipment according to US Coast Guard Regulations (1 PFD per person, sound signal, paddle, bailer). In addition, each boat must carry on board during the regatta a line, suitable for towing, at least 1/4" x 30 feet in length.

10. Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions will be available at the check-in/late registration table and may be posted online by Sep 1, 2018 at <u>Albacore North Americans</u> (YachtScoring) and the U.S. Albacore Association Facebook (<u>@albacoreracing</u>) page. SIs will govern in case of any inconsistency with this NOR.

11. Scoring: The low point system of Appendix A of the RRS will apply. Completion of at least one race shall constitute a series.

One race will be dropped if 5 or more races are sailed.

12. Crew Changes: Crew changes during an event may not be made unless permission is granted by the organizing committee in advance.

13. Awards: There will be awards for the Presidents Fleet (top five finishers) and the Challenger Fleet (new sailor/entry in NAs or top of bottom half of the fleet.)

• North American Presidents Trophy – Winner of the Presidents Fleet

- North American Challenge Trophy Winner of the Challenger Fleet
- North American Senior Trophy Top boat with combined crew age > 110 years*
- North American Top woman helm*
- North American Top Junior* Top helm 22 years or under as of last day of racing
- Endurance Award Lowest placing boat that <u>finishes</u> every race in the Presidents Fleet
- Most Improved Helm since 2016 North Americans

*Winners of top awards in President's Fleet may not be eligible.
