#### ELIGIBILITY

- Eligible yachts may be entered by completing the Entry form.

#### APPLICATION & ENTRY FEE

- Application shall be made by completing the online Entry Form, or by mail.
- Online Entry completion through [www.portclintonyachtclub.com](http://www.portclintonyachtclub.com) is recommended.
- Registration will close at 2000 Hrs. Saturday 08/31/19
- *Check-in is required prior to 2000 Hrs. on 08/31/19*
- Auxiliary registration is limited to the first eighty (80) visiting entries.
