



2019 THISTLE MIDWINTERS EAST NOTICE OF RACE St Petersburg Yacht Club, Organizing Authority 11 Central Avenue St Petersburg FL 33701 February 24-March 1, 2019

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* and the Thistle Class Rules.
- 1.2 As allowed by RRS88.2, the US Sailing prescriptions to RRS60, 63.2, & 63.4 do not apply.
- 1.3 RRS 63.7 shall be replaced by, "If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (SI's), the Sailing Instructions shall apply." This changes RRS 63.7.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 The event is open to all competitors who meet the Thistle Class Association eligibility requirements.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may register by completing the online entry form at www.yachtscoring.com and paying the required fees.
- 2.3 Competitor Check-in will be held on Sunday February 24th, 2018, at the SPYC Sailing Center from 1300-1600. All competitors shall sign a waiver at check-in at the SPYC Sailing Center.

3. Fees

The Entry Fee is \$250.00 per boat, for boats registering on or before February 13, 2019. The entry fee from February 14th 2019, until the close of registration on Friday February 24 is \$275.00 per boat. The entry fee includes 5 race days, 1 night hosted keg party, 3 Tiki Deck Cookout tickets, 3 Awards Banquet tickets, regatta trophies, 7% FL Sales Tax.

4. Schedule

5. Sailing Instructions will be available online and at check-in.

6. Venue

Boats will be launched from SPSC on Demen's Landing, 250 2nd Avenue SE. The racing area will be on Tampa Bay, east of the St Petersburg Pier.

7. Courses

The courses to be sailed may be Windward Leeward or Windward Leeward Triangles.

8. Scoring

8.1 The scoring system will be the low point scoring system of Appendix A, except that no score will be excluded.

8.2 Three races will constitute a regatta.

9. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to skippers and crews placing first through fifth in the A fleet (A Fleet includes skippers who have placed eighth or higher in a chevron event), and first through third in the B Fleet. The following perpetual trophies will be awarded: Miami Sunshine Regatta Trophy (top finisher overall), Sunshine Trophy (top finisher from Florida), Ol' Thistlin' Tom Trophy (top skipper 50 years or older).

10. Electronic Communications

10.1 RRS 41 in changed to allow the use of hand-held VHF radios, but only for receiving communications from the race committee, and in emergencies. Use of any other electronic communication devices, including cellular phones, is prohibited. 10.2 The following additional stipulations apply to the Thistle Class Association's Chief Measurer's Rulings 65 and 74: VHF radios may be utilized to monitor the weather channels at any time. The Race Committee may communicate safety or race related information on a designated channel. Competitors are encouraged to monitor the safety channel throughout the race when conditions warrant. Communication between competitors regarding any race information not related to safety is expressly prohibited.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority, the sponsors, the race committee, officers and board of directors of SPYC, and all those involved in these organizations will not accept any responsibility for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after this regatta.
