NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in this Notice of Race (NoR) means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 COMMUNICATIONS

2.1 The official notice board is electronic and will be located at

https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?elD=6228.

- 2.2 On the water, the race committee intends to make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 2.3 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 9, 13, 16, 68, 69, 70, 71, and 72.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Boats in the Alerion 28, Harbor 20, and J/70 classes are invited to participate.
- 3.2 For a class to have a start, it must have a minimum of 5 paid entries by 1200 on Friday, May 10. Entry fees for boats in classes that fail to meet the minimum will be returned.
- 3.3 Boats wishing to enter shall register on line at: <u>https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=6228</u>.
- 3.4 To be considered an entry in the regatta, a boat shall complete all registration steps and pay all fees.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Registration and entry fee of \$55 are due by 1700 on Monday, April 29. After that, registrations with an additional late fee of \$25 will be accepted until 1200 on Friday, May 10. Entry fees are payable in full upon registering and are non-refundable.
- 4.2 The entry fee includes, at a minimum, racing and awards.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 For the Alerion 28 and Harbor 20 classes: The warning signal for the first race of the regatta is scheduled for 1100. Three races are scheduled.
- 5.2 For the J/70 class: The warning signal for the first race of the regatta is scheduled for 1400. Multiple very short races will be sailed. No warning signal will be made after 1630.

5.3 After racing, all competitors are invited to a post-race party and awards presentation at AYC with complimentary beer and cash bar.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The SIs will consist of the instructions in "2019 AYC STANDARD DROP MARKS SAILING INSTRUCTIONS" (available at: <u>http://bit.ly/ayc-standardsi19</u> by April 15, 2019) and the event sailing instructions supplement that will be posted on the official notice board. The event sailing instructions supplement will be posted on the notice board by 1700 on Thursday, May 2.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The racing area will be Severn River east of the USNA.
- 7.2 The regatta venue will be the AYC Sailing Center.

8 THE COURSES

8.1 The courses to be sailed will be drop mark courses.

9 SCORING

9.1 RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply as changed by the SIs.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be given to the top 3 boats in each class.
- 10.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.
