



NOTICE OF RACE

Eastern Class E Scow Association 2019 Championship Regatta

Organizing Authority: Bay Head Yacht Club & Mantoloking Yacht Club

Location and Date:

The 2019 Eastern Class E Scow Association Championship takes place on Thursday August 1, 2019, through and including Saturday August 3, 2019, on the Barnegat Bay, co-hosted by the Bay Head Yacht Club (BHYC) & the Mantoloking Yacht Clubs (MYC) located at Metcalf Street, Bay Head, NJ and 1228 Bay Avenue, Mantoloking, NJ respectively.

Rules:

1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
2. All boats must display an NCESA registration sticker.

Required Safety Equipment:

1. Personal Flotation device for each member of the crew, as well as a throwable device.
2. Tow Line.
3. Main Sail Flotation Panels.
4. Anchor.

Note:

Failure to have required safety equipment is not protestable by a competitor but may result in a protest from the Race Committee. Penalty is DPI (Discretionary) and may be less than a DSQ.

Number of Races:

Seven (7) races are scheduled. The completion of three (3) races constitutes a Regatta. No warning signal shall be made after 1300 on Saturday, August 3, 2019 unless there have only been two (2) races completed, in which case the time for the warning signal may be extended to no later than 1500. If six races are sailed, each boat series score shall be the total of her races excluding her worst. This changes RRS A2.

**Scoring:**

RRS A4 low point system

Awards:

Top 5 Skippers, Top 5 Crews, Top Vintage Boat Skipper, Top Rookie and Top Master.
(Master is a skipper whose age is 65 or greater as of July 31, 2019).

Fees:

Entry fee for registrations received on or before June 30, 2019 is \$325 for boats whose skipper was born on or before July 31, 1994 or \$250 for Skipper born on or after August 1, 1994. Entry fee must be paid on the Yacht Scoring website prior to June 30, 2019 to receive the standard entry fee rate.

Entry fee for registrations received after June 30, 2019 is \$375 for boats whose skipper was born on or before July 31, 1994 or \$275 for Skipper born on or after August 1, 1994.

All skippers must be Regular Members of the NCESA and need to join before the regatta at www.e-scow.org.

Registration and Procedure:

Online regatta registration, social packages at www.yachtscoring.com. Pre-order regatta wear is available online at <http://www.coralreefsailing.com>.

Measurement:

Measurement takes place at the Mantoloking Yacht Club from 13:00 – 19:00 on Wednesday July 31, 2019.

Boats not having a weight sticker, or a lead seal are not eligible to compete and will have to be weighed and weights sealed. Should measurement conditions not be deemed acceptable by the Class Measurer, no weigh-in will occur.

Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions will be available online no later than July 31, 2019 at www.yachtscoing.com, as well as at the Check-in / Late Registration table.

Radio Use:

The RC will communicate with competitors on VHF radio channel 69. The order of transmission or failure to hear a RC transmission shall not constitute grounds for redress. Notification of course changes after the start may be broadcast by the RC in addition to the signals. Please bring a VHF radio.
