

Quantum Key West 2013 Sailing Instructions

AMENDMENT #1 WEIGH-IN

1. *WHO*

The following classes must have their crews weighed in prior to 1000 Monday, January 21: Farr 40 High Performance J/80 Melges 24 Melges 32 Swan 42 52 Class

2. WHEN

There are four designated time frames for weigh-in*:

1300 – 1800 Friday January 18

0900 - 1800 Saturday January 19

0900 - 1800 Sunday January 20

0830 - 1000 Monday January 21 (for emergencies and late arrivals only)

3. WHERE

Weigh-in will be on site at Kelly's Caribbean Bar & Grill (corner of Caroline and Whitehead Streets). Crews are to check in at the weigh-in desk in Kelly's lower courtyard.

4. HOW

Crews are to report together for weigh-in. The skipper or skipper's representative is to print crew names on the form provided. All weights will be verified using the scales provided by designated Race Committee members. Clothing worn at weigh-in is optional, but must consist of at least briefs.

5. SUBSTITUTIONS

5.1 With the exception of the 52 Class, crew substitutions are allowed. It is the responsibility of the skipper to have substitute crew members weighed-in prior to 1000 on race days (Tuesday – Friday) at the Race Office. A crew substitution card, with the name of the substitute and the crew member replaced, must be submitted when being weighed in and signed by the designated Race Committee Official. Crew substitution cards are available at the Race Office.

5.2 Crew substitutions for the 52 Class are only according to 52 Super Series NOR 12.1.
