**SUPPLEMENT to the STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS  
(Numbering corresponds to the RRS Appendix S)**

*[DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the protest committee.*

**2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

- 2.1. Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the veranda of the island club house.
- 2.2. Supplementary sailing instructions (called ‘the supplement’ below) will be posted on the official notice board.

**4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

- 4.1. The flagpole from which signals made ashore will be displayed is located beside the RCYC sailing office.

**5. SCHEDULE OF RACES**

- 5.1. Dates of racing: Saturday, June 1 and Sunday, June 2, 2019
- 5.2. Number of races:

Class	Number of Races	Maximum Races per day
J105	7	4
Etchells	7	4
8mR	5	3
VX One	6	4

- 5.3. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday is 1100 hrs.
- 5.4. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Sunday is 1030 hrs.
- 5.5. On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 1430 hrs.

**7. THE COURSES**

- 7.1. The course diagrams are in Attachment A. They show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. Only the courses shown in Attachment A will be used for the event.

- 7.2 On Alpha Course, if Code E is displayed with the warning signal for a race, the course to be sailed for that race will be the extended course. If Code E is not displayed, the course to be sailed will be the standard course.
- 7.3 Marks 2 and 2a are not marks of the extended course.
- 7.4 Where there is a gate, if one of the gate marks is missing, the remaining gate mark shall be rounded to port.
- 7.5 Where either Mark 1 or Mark 1a is missing, the remaining mark (1a or 1) shall be rounded to port.
- 7.6 Where either Mark 2 or 2a is missing, the remaining mark (2a or 2) shall be rounded to port.
- 7.7 The 8mR and J105 classes are assigned to **Alpha** course.
- 7.8 The Etchells and VX One classes are assigned to **Bravo** course.

## 8. MARKS

- 8.1 The marks of the Course for **Alpha** Course are described in the table below.

- 8.2 The marks of the Course for **Bravo** Course are described in the table below.

### START

- 9.1 The Race Committee may announce the sail number or boat name of each premature starter on the applicable VHF channel. Failure to make an announcement, and the order in which boats are announced, will not be grounds for redress. This changes Rule 62.1 (a).
- 9.2 When more than 5 minutes has elapsed since the starting signal for the previous race, the race committee may make several short sound signals or display an orange flag with one signal, not more than five minutes nor less than one minute before the warning signal for the race. Failure to make a signal or display a flag will not be grounds for a redress. This changes Rules 62.1 (a).

## **12. TIME LIMITS**

12.1 Time limits are as follows:

## **15. SAFETY REGULATIONS**

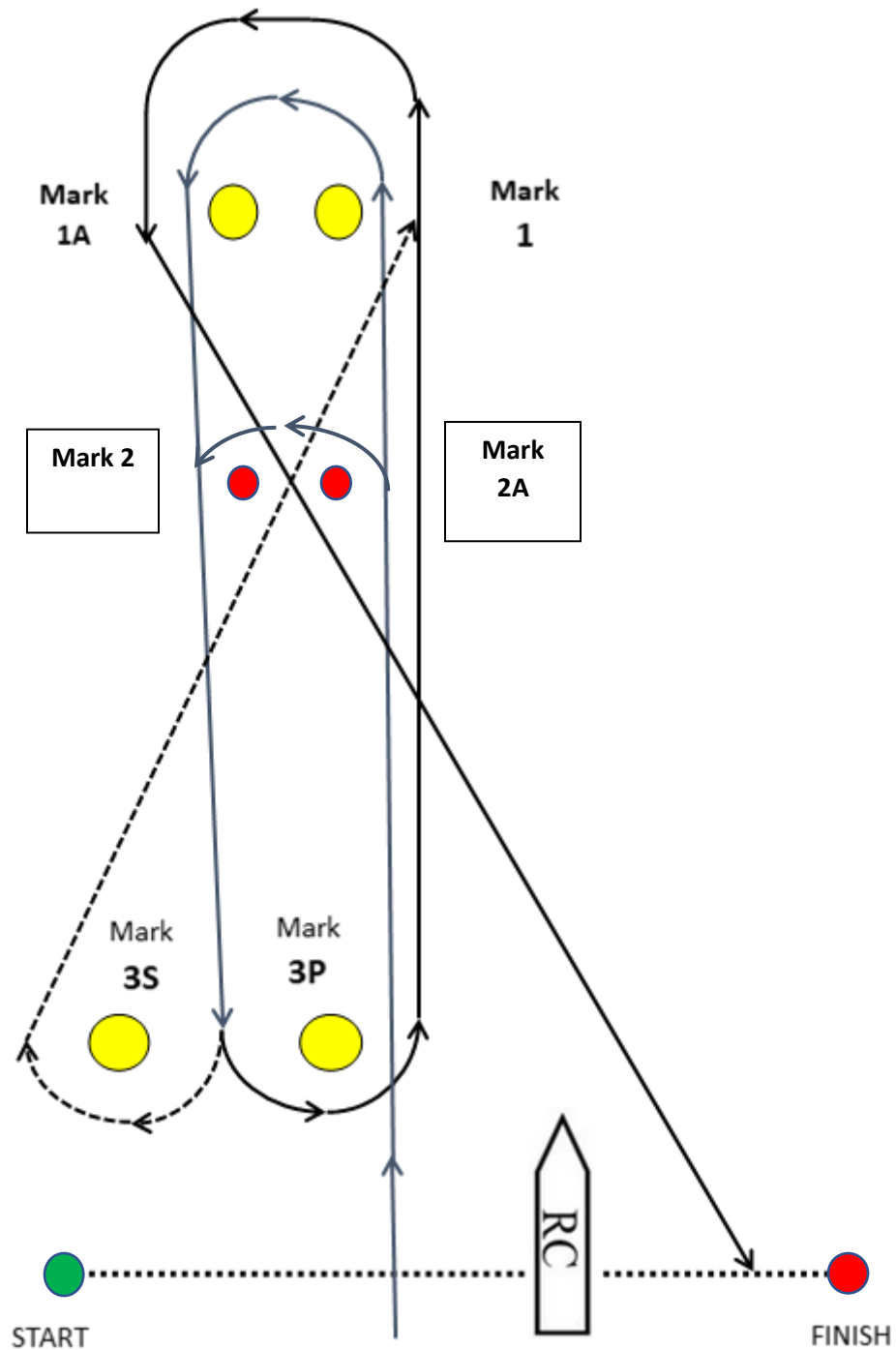
15.1 A boat that leaves the race area before the end of racing for the day shall notify a race official as soon as possible. [DP]

16.1 The VHF channel used on Alpha Course will be 69.

16.2 The VHF channel used on Bravo Course will be 71.

## Attachment A – Alpha Course

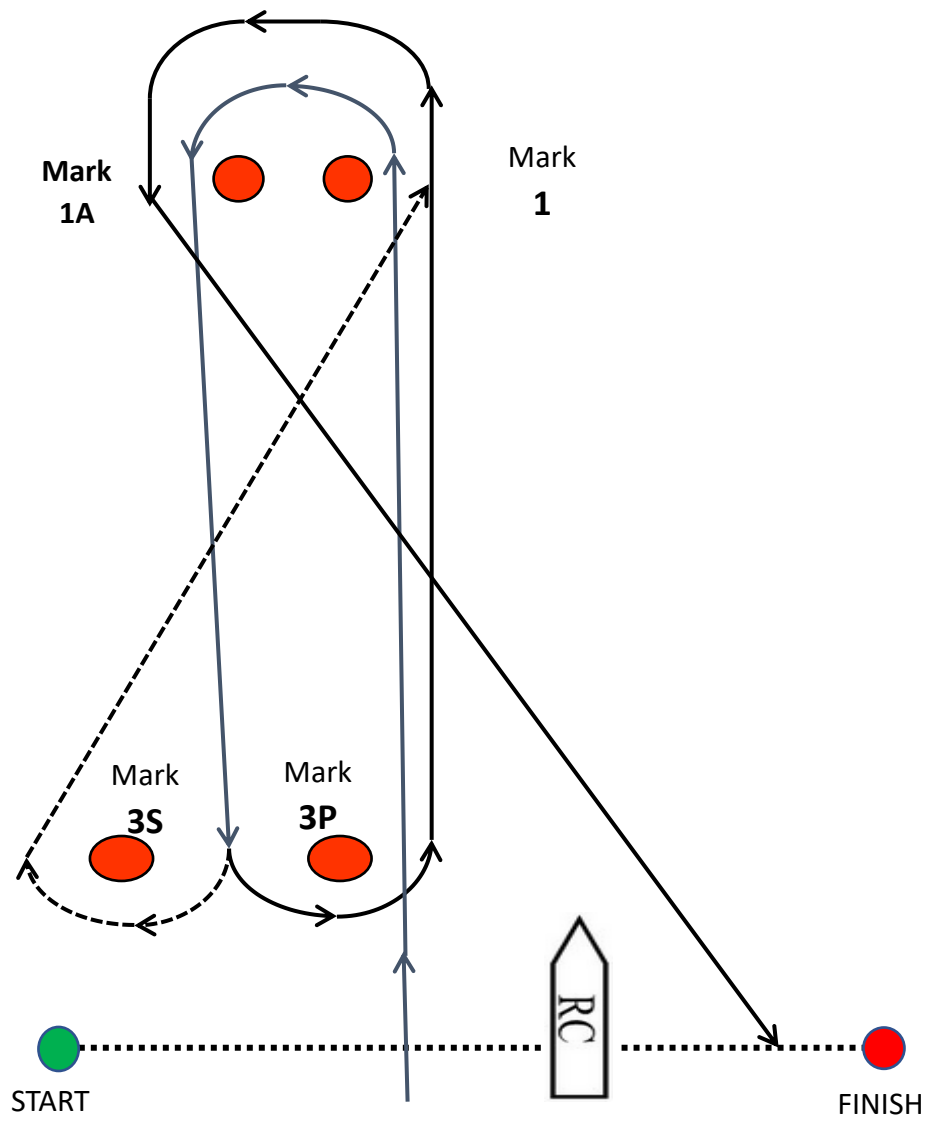


**Extended Course (Flag E):** Start – 1 – 1A – gate (3S/3P) – 1 – 1A – Finish

**Standard Course (no Flag):** Start – 2 – 2A – gate (3S/3P) – 2 – 2A – Finish

2 and 2A are not marks of the extended course.

**Course:** Start – 1 – 1A – gate (3S/3P) – 1 – 1A – Finish
