NOTICE OF RACE

Hosting: Soverel 33 National Championships 2013 Viper 640 New England Championship 2013

Classes included in previous years:

J/105 J/80 J109 Beneteau 36.7 Farr 30 J-30 Melges 24 Viper 640

RULES The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Each boat must be equipped

with a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on channel 77. All classes must comply with the minimum equipment requirements of YRALIS Cat C and class rules. Class-required measurement will be specified in Class

Addendum documents posted not later than May 27th.

ELIGIBILITY Open to all One Design classes over 20 feet with sufficient entries. Entries sufficent to constitute a class must be

received by May 24th, 2013. Minimum class size requirements must be met to be accepted. There will be a limit of

six classes.

Eligible boats may enter by completing the official entry process on YachtScoring.com and paying all fees, through **ENTRIES**

May 26th. Entries after May 26th will incur a \$50 late fee and, if space permits, may be accepted through May 31st.

If received by May 26th, the entry fees are: **ENTRY FEE**

> • One Design Classes between 20-29 feet. \$150

> • All other One Design Classes 30 feet and above \$190

Entry fees include sailing, berthing, launching or single-point hoist if needed, and all social activities.

INSTRUCTIONS Sailing Instructions will be available at CPYC and online after May 29th and will be included in the skipper bag to be

picked up prior to sailing at the regatta desk. A number of copies may be available from the Race Committee in the starting area. An unofficial copy of the Sailing Instructions will be available on-line at www.yachtscoring.com

SCORING The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply, except that there will be no throw out unless five races are

completed. One race will constitute a regatta.

SCHEDULE Harbor start will be at 0930. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1100 each day. The number of races will be

determined by the race committee. No warning signal will be made after 1500 on Sunday.

RACE AREA Races will be sailed on Long Island Sound south of Bell 24.

COURSES Courses will be windward/leeward, or as described in the Sailing Instructions.

PRIZES Awards will be given to the top three finishers in each class following racing on Sunday. We also expect to have a

raffle for all sailors of the many prizes donated to us by our generous sponsors.

The Club's five-ton hoist will be available for launching and hauling (free if using single-point setup). Free dockage, LOGISTICS

> as available. A limited number of trailers can be stored on-site. For dockage and hoist reservations and instructions, contact Trey Lang, Club Manager at 203-226-7411 no later than May 30. First come, first served. Boats may be rafted. The five-ton hoist will be available on a reservation basis during the week and as needed Saturday and Sunday. Boats may be hoisted with a single-point setup or the club's spreader bar, and certain masts can be stepped using the hoist, but the club has no gin pole setup. Directions and particulars about driving trailers and

navigating boats to the Club are posted on the regatta site at www.yachtscoring.com.

INSURANCE

Each boat shall hold adequate insurance including third-party liability insurance, and it is the owner or owners' representative's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to participating in this event. Gowrie Group (www.gowrie.com) may be able to assist with insurance needs.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INJURY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk.
