Amendment #1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. In SI Appendix A Around-the-Island Race, change the VHF Channel as shown below:
 - A1.1 The intended order of start for the Around-the-Island Race on Friday, June 14, will be included in the Race Committee's announcement on VHF Channel 72 at 0900. Classes may not start in numerical order. The Race Committee may combine two or more classes into one start by displaying multiple class flags at the Warning Signal. The Race Committee will endeavor to announce the next class(es) to start on VHF Channel 7269.
 - A2.1 The Race Committee will use VHF channel 72-69 for the Around-the-Island Race on Friday, June 14.
 - A2.2 The flag(s) designating the course to be sailed will be displayed at Course Signals. The Race Committee will endeavor to announce the designated courses over VHF channel 7269. Failure to make such an announcement shall not be grounds for redress. This changes rule 62.1(a).
- 2. In SI Appendix D Red Fleet Drop Mark Races, change SI D1.2 as follows:
 - D1.2 Course The course is a Windward/Leeward course and will be designated by the letter flag "W".

 The course, number of legs, direction and distance to the first windward mark will be displayed on a white board, over a numeral pennant indicating the number of legs. The offset leg will not count in the total number of legs. Marks, including the windward offset mark, shall be rounded in order and left to port, except that a gate, when used, shall be rounded as described rule 28.1(c).
