## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016*.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all vessels with a valid PHRF rating.

2.2 In the spirit of the event, vessels are encouraged to take along junior sailors for the race. Vessels are encouraged to request any number of junior sailors from DRYA area. Email Race Chairman, Will Cyr ([willcyr@umich.edu](mailto:willcyr@umich.edu)) who will coordinate junior sailor assignments.

2.3 Division splits and class selections will be posted at the latest on Friday, September 6<sup>th</sup>.

2.4 The normal entry deadline is August 25<sup>th</sup>. Late entries will be accepted until Friday, September 6<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM.

### 3. ENTRY FEES

The Entry Fee is \$30. Late Entries will be charged an additional \$5.

Awards shall be presented to the top finishers of each class. An overall award will be presented to the vessel the fastest corrected time and a junior sailor on board.
