SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 — Rules —

1.1 - The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

1.2 - All times for the event will be GPS time. Please set your watches accordingly.

2 — Notices to Competitors — will be posted on the Official Notice Board located in the GTYC foyer.

3 — Changes To Sailing Instructions — will be posted ninety(90) minutes prior to the first warning signal on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1900 hrs on the day before it will take effect.

4 — Signals Made Ashore —

4.1 - Signals made ashore will be displayed from the GTYC flagstaff and broadcast on VHF channel 72.

4.2 - When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than sixty (60) minutes' in Race Signal AP. This changes Race Signal AP.

6 — Class Flags — will be - SPNKR A Fleet — Yellow SPNKR B Fleet — White JAM — Green

7 — Racing Area — will be West Grand Traverse Bay. (see Attachment A)

8 — The Courses — for all courses, except M, marks shall be left to port, except the finish mark for courses 4W, 6W, and 5T. Weather offset marks and leeward gates will NOT be used.

3W---- Three(3) Leg W/L (windward, leeward, windward)

4W---- Four(4) Leg W/L (windward, leeward, windward, leeward)

5W---- Five(5) Leg W/L (windward, leeward, windward, leeward, windward)

6W---- Six(6) Leg W/L (windward, leeward, windward, leeward, windward, leeward)

4T---- Four(4) Leg Triangle (triangle, windward).

5T---- Five(5) Leg Triangle (triangle, windward, leeward).

O---- Olympic Triangle (triangle, windward, leeward, windward).

M---- Middle Distance Courses - as below.

M Course - LONG (approx 12 nm)

Start - between RC Boat and X

YC - S

R8 - P

C7 - P

Finish - between RC Boat and X in front of Club

M Course - SHORT (approx 6 nm)

9 — Marks —

- 9.1 - Courses 3W, 4W, 5W, 6W, 4T, 5T, & O — Primary marks will be large orange tetrahedrons.
- 9.2 - New marks, as provided in SI 12, will be yellow.
- 9.3 - Middle Distance Course — Marks will be a combination of orange tetrahedrons, fixed navigational marks, and GTYC Race Marks (for approximate locations see chart on page 3).

10 — The Start —

- 10.1 — The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the RC signal boat at the starboard end and the leeward mark at the port end.
- 10.2 — A boat starting later than five (5) minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS). This changes RRS A4.1
- 10.3 — Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area while others are in sequence.

11 — Recalls — Individual Recalls will be signaled in accordance with RRS 29.2. The RC intends to make an attempt to hail OCS competitors on VHF channel 72. The following are not grounds for redress: failure of the RC to hail any or all boats; failure of the RC to accurately hail one or more boats; failure of a boat to hear its hail; timeliness of the hail; or the order of boats within the hail.

12 — Change of the Next Leg of the Course — To change the next leg of the course, the RC will lay a new mark and remove the original as soon as practicable. When in a subsequent change a new mark is replaced, it will be replaced by an original mark.

13 — The Finish —

- 13.1 - For courses 3W, 5W, 4T, O - the finishing line will be between a staff displaying an Orange Flag on a RC Boat at the Starboard end and the course side of the nearby Weather Mark at the Port end.
- 13.2 - For courses 4W, 6W & 5T - the finishing line will be between a staff displaying an Orange Flag on a RC Boat at the Port end and the course side of the nearby Leeward Mark at the Starboard end.
- 13.3 - For course M the finish will be between the RC boat and a buoy outside of the mooring area in front of GTYC.
- 13.4 - In the absence of an RC boat at the finish, boats shall take their own times when their bow crosses a line perpendicular to the last leg and within 50 yds of the finish mark and report this time on the Finish Time Sheets attached.

14 — Time Limits — are as follows —

- 14.1 - For all courses, except M, the time limit will be ninety (90) minutes.
- 14.2 - For course M the time limit will be two (2) hours.
- 14.3 - For all courses, except M, any boat failing to finish within thirty (30) minutes after the first boat in their fleet sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF). For course M this time will be forty (40) minutes.

15 — Protests And Requests For Redress —

- 15.1 — Protests shall be filed within the protest time limit at GTYC where forms will be available.
- 15.2 — The protest time limit will be 60 minutes after the RC Platform Boat docks. This time will be posted on the Official Notice Board and will be announced on VHF Channel 72.
- 15.3 — Notices will be posted within thirty (30) minutes of the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Location of hearings TBD.

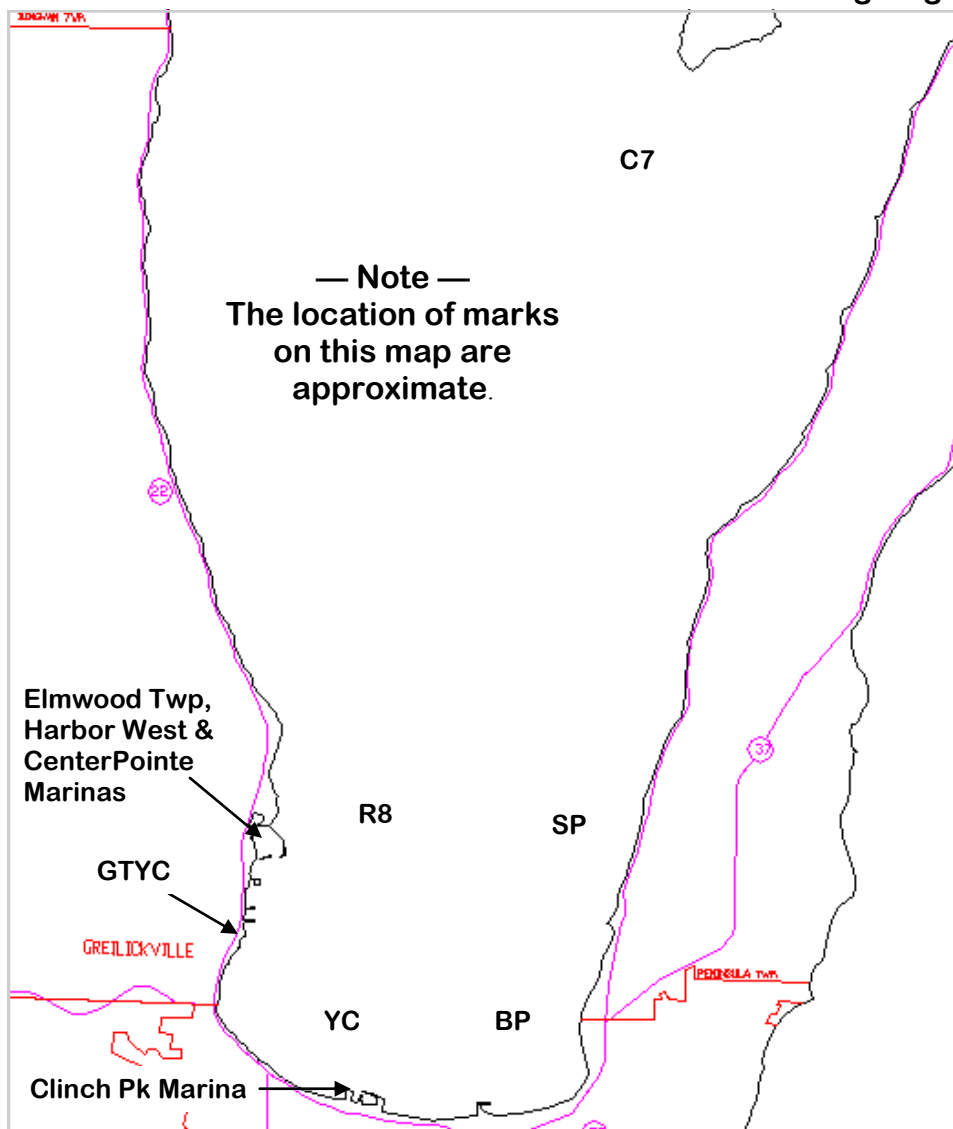
16 — Scoring —

- 16.1 — All races will be scored using PHRF Time On Time Handicaps. Entrants that do not have a valid LMPHRF certificate will be assigned a rating.
- 16.2 — Seven races are scheduled and one race must be completed to constitute a series.
- 16.3 — A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores (no throwout). This changes RRS App A.
- 16.4 — Any boat that does not finish (DNF) or retires (RET) shall be scored one more point than the last place finisher in that race.

17 — Prizes — will be awarded to first, second, & third place overall for each fleet.

18 — Disclaimer Of Liability — Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
