## Notice of Race

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2013 - 2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including the US SAILING prescriptions.
- 1.2 Individual Class Rules will apply subject to the following modifications:
  - a. Skippers are not required to be a member of the class
  - b. VHF radios are permitted.
  - c. Weight limits are waived
- 1.3 Bayview Yacht Club Club Boat Handling Policy will apply to the Ultimate 20 class, including **USCG-approved PFDs shall be worn at all times** by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing.
- 1.4 Competitors shall not interfere with commercial shipping transiting the racing area at any time.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Only the helmsperson is required to be female.
- 2.2 The **Regatta** is open to any boat that has a **PHRF** rating assigned by DRYA, a local rating organization, or a recognized **One-Design** class. Three or more registered boats in any One-Design class wishing to compete will be granted their own scoring start.

### 3. ENTRY

- 3.1 Please register at [yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=885](http://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=885) and pay the entry fee of \$30.00.
- 3.2 If you plan to charter an Ultimate 20, please fill out the separate charter form available at the registration site. (Boats will be chartered on a first-come, first-served basis.)

**3.3 Deadline for entry is 5 p.m., Friday, June 21. Entries attempted after the deadline will be at the sole discretion of the Organizing Authority and may carry a late fee of \$10.00.**

#### **4. COURSES**

**4.1** The Course will be set in the Southwestern portion of Lake St. Clair. The Start will be near the head of the Detroit River.

**4.2** All competitors will monitor VHF Channel 72 for verbal instructions.

#### **7. REGISTRATION**

will be open Friday, June 21, 2013 at 1600 hrs. Sailing Instructions will be available Wednesday, June 19, 2013 online at [yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=885](http://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=885) and in the Bayview Bar.

#### **8. SCORING**

The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A4 will apply. One completed race will constitute a Regatta.

#### **9. COURTESY BROADCASTS**

The Race Committee may provide general information to competitors on VHF Channel 72. Information so provided will not be subject to action under RRS 62.

#### **10. PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded to each yacht placing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> in class. However, if less than 5 boats compete in a class; prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place only. The first place winners in each class will have their names inscribed on the **Natalie J. O’Niel Trophy**.
