## CHANGE #1 to the Sailing Instructions

March 5 – March 8, 2014

## Attachment III: Class Specific *Rule* Changes for Vipers is replaced with the following:

## 1 The following *rules* are changed for Viper 640's:

- 1.1 No crew substitutions are allowed during the course of the regatta without the express written permission of the Race Committee who shall consult the Viper class representative, changing Viper 640 Class Rule 10.6 with permission of the class.
- 1.2 PENALTY SYSTEM FOR VIPER 640's The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 while *racing*. However, when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 while in the *zone* around a *mark* other than a starting *mark*, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.' This also changes the NoR Viper 640 Class Addendum.
- 1.3 Viper 640's will be required to display an EFG mainsail logo as provided at the Registration desk or available from the Viper Class Representative. This instruction is not subject to protest by another boat and penalties are at the discretion of the International Jury, changing RRS 60.1 and 64.1.
- 1.4 SI 15.2 and the NoR Viper 640 Class Addendum are changed to the following for Viper 640's "SCORING: Bacardi Sailing Week Regatta (the Regatta) is the finale of the EFG Pan American Championship. Each boat carries forward into the finale a "qualification score" ranging from 1 point to 7 points incurred during the qualification rounds of the EFG Pan American Championship. Each boat's score in the Regatta shall be the total of her qualification score and her race scores excluding her worst race score, except that if less than five races are sailed, each boat's Regatta score shall be the total of her qualification score and all her race scores."
- 1.5 The following is added to the NoR Viper Class Addendum "AWARDS:
  - The winner of the EFG Pan American Championship is engraved on the Pan American Perpetual Trophy and receives a replica of the trophy.
  - First through fifth of the Pan American Championship will receive awards.
  - The perpetual Governor's Cup is awarded to the winner in the Master's division for the highest placed skipper of 55 or over."
