1 NOTICE OF RACE

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The 2019 Monroe Skyline Series part of the 2019 Chicago Beer Can Series is open to all sailboats owned by members of the Chicago Yacht Club in good standing.
- 2.2 All eligible boats must complete the registration for **BOTH** Columbia Yacht Club and Chicago Yacht Club.

Chicago Yacht Club Registration:
- 2.3 The entry fee for Columbia Yacht Club is \$75.00 (NOR 4.1).
The entry fee for Chicago Yacht Club is \$20.00.
- 2.4 All Chicago Yacht Club registered boats shall maintain to the best of their ability an accumulative list of regular crew with email addresses. A protest for this requirement only may be initiated by the Race Committee and an accurate crew list presented before a hearing, at the time of hearing or at the time of appeal shall exonerate the boat.
- 2.5 On August 7, there will be the 100 Boat Beer Can Race. Information and registration is available at: <http://chicagosailracing.org/>

3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Racing shall occur Wednesday nights from May 15 until September 11 with the 2019 Chicago Beer Cans Series.
- 3.2 Racing shall also occur on Wednesday, September 18 and 25. Courses to be explained in Sailing Instructions, Addendum A.
- 3.3 There shall be no racing on either July 10 or July 17 due to the Chicago Yacht Club Race to Mackinac.

5 SCORING

- 5.1 See NOR 11
- 5.2 Monroe Skyline Fleet will be scored for the “Tune-Up Race” scheduled on May 15 for both daily and series awards. ***This changes NOR 11.***
- 5.2 Registered boats shall be scored by both Chicago Yacht Club and Columbia Yacht Club and are eligible for awards at both clubs.

6 AWARDS

- 6.1 Race Awards and Special Prizes will be presented at the After Racing Social. A boat's representative must be present to receive an award or prize.
- 6.2 Weekly prizes may be given at the discretion of the Organizing Authority to maximize fun and camaraderie.
- 6.3 There will be Season Series Awards for the top three (3) boats in each section and for the overall fleet. These will be awarded at the Annual CYC Offshore Awards Dinner.

7 AFTER RACING SOCIAL

- 7.1 There will be an After Party with a buffet and drink specials on the patio at the Chicago Yacht Club Monroe Station after each Wednesday night race for all participants from the Chicago Yacht Club. The main dining room will also be open with extended hours.
- 7.2 Drink and meal tickets can be purchased with cash, credit cards or member charge. Ordering off the menu is by member charge only.
- 7.3 There will be an End of Season Party, which will be announced at a later date.
