The Vermilion T-10 Fleet 15 is the Organizing Authority for this regatta, in cooperation with the T-10 Class and the Vermilion Boat Club.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The T-10 North American Championship (NAC) will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the T-10 Class Rules, and T-10 North American Championship Regulations, except as any of these are altered by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions. Where a conflict exists between the NOR and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will govern.
- 1.2 This North American Championships is designated ISAF Category A.
- 1.3 Removable bow numbers of contrasting color shall be attached to both sides of the boat's hull at all times while racing. The stickers are to be attached with the top approximately 8-10" below deck level and with the leading edge approximately 10-12" aft of the bow. Bow stickers will be provided in the Regatta Skipper Package at registration.
- 1.4 Sponsor or other regatta stickers may be required to be attached to each side of each boat as required by the Organizing Authority.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The owner/charter shall be a member in good standing of the T-10 Class Association. All contestants must be eligible in accordance with the Eligibility, Article 6, of the T-10 NAC Regulations.
- 2.2 The yacht shall have a valid 2006 T-10 Measurement Certificate.
- 2.3 Proof of ownership in the form of title or registration or proof of charter must be supplied with the entry form.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 All Entry Forms are due on or before **Saturday, July 15th, 2006**. Late entries will be accepted until Saturday, Aug. 5th, 2006 with an additional \$175 late fee. ***NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER AUG. 5TH, 2006.*** Entry Fee (\$350) must be sent to the *2006 North American Championship, c/o Vermilion Boat Club, 5416 Liberty Ave., Vermilion, Ohio 44089*. Please make checks payable to: 2006 T-10 NAC.

- 3.3 All Eligible yachts may enter the Regatta by submitting the following: Entry Fee, Official Entry Form, 2006 Certificate of Measurement, Proof of Ownership or Charter (title or DNR registration) and Certificate of Insurance with minimum \$300,000 liability coverage. *Entry Fee and Official Entry Form must be submitted by Saturday, July 15th, 2006 or by Saturday, Aug. 5th, 2006 (additional late fee applies). All other forms are required no later than registration.*

4. REGISTRATION & MEASUREMENT

- 4.1 Registration will be conducted in the tent outside of the Vermilion Boat Club on Tuesday, Aug 8th, 2006, 12pmEST – 8pmEST and on Wednesday, Aug. 9th, 2006, 8amEDT – 8pm EST. The Sailing Instructions will be made available at registration. Amendments to the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Notice Board by 0800 EST daily.
- 4.2 Crew lists, weight, and waivers, Inspections and Sail Measurement Registration will be conducted at or before Registration. Crew lists, weight and waivers, Sail Measurement Certificates, Certificate

of Insurance, Proof of Ownership, Required Equipment list and payment of any other fees shall be completed in order to register.

- 4.3 In addition to Sail Measurement, the NAC Regatta Measurement Staff may inspect and measure any “measurable” item of any yacht.
- 4.4 Consistent with Regulation 7 of the T-10 Class NAC Regulations, the crew list will identify all persons pre-registered as crew. Each boat may present additional alternate crew members who may be substituted as permitted under NAC Regulation 7.1. Each boat shall sail with the all persons pre-registered as crew. Crew substitution is limited to a person from the alternate crew listed and weighed at registration and only by application to and with the permission of the Championship Committee or the Board of Directors.

5. LAUNCHING

- 5.1 Launching and haul out will be provided for all T-10’s (other than boats within a 50-mile driving radius of Vermilion) at Parsons’ Marina, 636 Sandusky St., Vermilion, Ohio 44089. Boats requesting to be launched and/or hauled out must make arrangements prior to Aug. 5th, 2006 with Cliff Parsons at (440) 967-7910. Boats within the 50-mile driving radius of Vermilion may be launched and/or hauled for a nominal fee.
- 5.2 No haul outs during the Regatta with the exception of emergency repairs approved by a NAC Judge. No boats will be hauled out prior to Sunday, Aug. 13th, 2006.

6. BERTHING

- 6.1 Berthing shall be at the Vermilion Boat Club and assigned by the 2006 NAC Dockmaster. All regatta participants MUST dock at the Vermilion Boat Club unless prior approval and arrangement have been made with the 2006 NAC Dockmaster.
- 6.2 An additional yacht (ie: support boat) may be docked at the Water Works Municipal docks at the owner’s expense depending on availability. A limited number of docks will be reserved for this Regatta. Please make arrangements for additional yachts with the 2006 NAC Dockmaster.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 Sailing Instructions shall be provided upon completion of Registration at the Vermilion Boat Club.
- 7.2 Preliminary Sailing Instructions which may or may not be the finalized copy, will be available for the Practice Race on Wednesday, Aug. 10th, 2006

8. RACING AREA

Racing area will be on the waters of Lake Erie and detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

10. COURSES

Courses and Course length shall be in accordance with the T-10 NAC Regatta Regulation Article 11, revised 12/04/04

11. SCORING

11.1 The NAC Regatta Regulation Article 10.1 shall be modified as per the Low-Point Scoring System of the RRS Appendix A. Each boat's series score will be the sum of the scores for all races. This changes RRS A2 "No score will be excluded".

11.2 For scoring purposes, the RRS Appendix A4.2 shall be in effect. This changes the NAC Regatta Regulation Article 10.3.

12. PRIZES

12.1 Prizes shall be awarded in accordance with the T-10 NAC Regatta Regulation Article 3.

12.2 Prizes will be awarded for yachts placing first through third in each race, and first through fifth Overall in the Regatta. Prizes will be awarded each day of racing.

12.3 The Perpetual Trophies will be presented at the Closing Ceremony.

12.4 Other special trophies may be awarded.
