

## **Travel Grant**

Travel Grants are available to sailors with disabilities competing in the Independence Cup (IC) and the US Para Sailing Championship (USPSC) who require financial assistance for travel and lodging. Both full and partial Grants are provided by the Judd Goldman Adaptive Sailing Foundation (JGASF).

## **Guidelines**

- 1. The Grants are available to registered IC and USPSC sailors and limited to travel and lodging only.
- 2. Grants will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis, with an emphasis on financial need.
- 3. The primary residence of the applicant must be **500 miles or more** from the IC Regatta sight.
- 4. The Grant will not exceed **\$500** per competitor nor more than **\$1000** per boat crew.
- 5. The recipient must attend the pre-race Clinic, the three-day Regatta and all IC event activities.
- Recipients need to state in the Applicant's Statement why they should receive a grant (in 250 words or less). The reasons <u>must</u> include: (1) explanation of need for financial assistance (be specific) (2) sailing experience (3) statement of whether you have received financial aid or assistance from another party for any costs that may be incurred for this specific regatta and/or trip.
- Grant application deadline is June 21, 2019. Completed applications should be submitted to: JGASF@juddgoldmansailing.org or fax (312) 644-3577). Applications will be reviewed and awards announced prior to the late IC fee registration date of July 8, 2019. IC applicants not qualifying for a JGASF Grant have until the late registration deadline to make alternative arrangements.
