Given Race cancellation last year, the Steve Bickell "Most Improved" Memorial Trophy will be presented to the PHRF skipper/boat with the largest numerical increase of finish position based Trophy: on PHRF Fleet Overall Scoring when results of the 2019 race are compared to the 2017 race results.

(Skipper/boat must be the same as 2017)

Overall The Joseph Waldschmitt Memorial "Best in Fleet" trophy will be presented to the winner of the

It is incumbent on the competitor to time the start correctly. If any part of a boat's hull, crew or equipment is on the course side (OCS) of the starting line at immediately prior to her starting signal and she is identified, the race committee will hail her sail number in accordance with Appendix S. Failure of the competitor to hear the hail or failure of the race committee to time it accurately will not be grounds for a request for redress. This changes rule 62.1(a).

Course: South out of St. George Creek to a port rounding of St. Mary's "SM" (FI (2+1) R6s), St. Mary's River

1 SAFETY REGULATIONS

1.1. A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible.

1.2. A boat shall carry all equipment required by her class rules. If not so specified, she shall also carry one USCG approved PFD, of the appropriate class, for each person on board.

1.3. All boats shall have available an appropriate line, not less than 25 feet long, which can be used for towing. Violation of this provision is not subject to protest or cause for redress.

1.4. All Competitors under the age of 18 are required to wear USCG Approved Personal Flotation Devices at ALL TIMES while on the water except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. This includes the time from when the boat leaves the club pier or other launch

point until she returns to that launch point. This changes the Part 4 preamble and Rule 40. Boats that do not comply with this regulation will be scored DNC.

- 1.5. Competitors aged 18 or older should always be alert for a code flag Y displayed from any Race Committee boat invoking Rule 40. Competitors that do not comply with rule 40 when Code Flag Y is displayed shall be scored DNC.
- 1.6. The Gov Cup race can result in boats remaining on the water after sundown. Competitors are hereby reminded to have and employ legal night lighting aboard their vessels.

2. TRASH DISPOSAL

2.1. Boats shall not put trash in the water. Trash may be placed aboard support and race committee boats.

3. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

3.1. Sailboat Racing is an inherently dangerous activity that may result in injury or death. Competitors participate in the SMCM Governor's Cup small boat race entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after this event.

Course:

Pass to port: Smith Point Light, Potomac Mo(a) "A", then St. Mary's "SM" to starboard. In addition, St. Mary's River Mark G"1" (FI G2.5s) shall be left to port, R"2" (FL R4s) left to starboard, G"3" (FI G6s) shall be left to port.

Distance:

48.5 nautical miles

Check-in:

Yachts must check in with the race committee prior to starting. Yachts failing to check in will be scored DNC.

GPS Tracking:

GPS tracking will use Kattack, using the device of your choice, see http://wp.kattack.com/ for details. It is strongly encouraged to be on board and activated. As per RRS 41 c) use and monitoring of GPS tracking by competitors while racing any leg of the 2019 Governor's Cup is approved.

Starting Line:

Between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and Rappahannock "1R". (Note: 'keep away' buoy, if present, is a part of the committee boat)

Finishing Line:

Between the yellow flag on the committee boat and the cross on Church Point. Yachts finishing in darkness shall illuminate sail numbers for identification purposes. All yachts shall record the finishers immediately ahead and behind them.

Time Limit:

Each yacht finishing before 1530 on Saturday 5 August 2019 will be recorded by the finish boat. Boats finishing after 1530 on Saturday 5 August 2019 shall note their finishing time and record it on the official notice board located at the "check-in" table at the James P. Muldoon River Center. Finishing time will be taken as the cross on Church Point passes 90 degrees magnetic off the starboard bow.

Recalls:

Recalls will follow C.B.Y.R.A. General Sailing Instructions. The race committee will attempt to notify premature starters on VHF channel 68.

Non-Finishers:

Yachts withdrawing after the starting signal shall notify the Race Committee by calling 240-895-4291 and leaving a message on the answering machine.

Refunds:

Requests for refunds of entry fees will be honored when the requests are in writing and are postmarked prior to 1630 hrs. July 28, 2019. Please allow 4 weeks for refund. Phone requests and requests postmarked after July 28, 2019 deadline will not be honored.

Protests:

Protests shall be written on standard C.B.Y.R.A. protest forms and lodged at the Sailors Information Table within one and one half hours of the protesting yacht's finish. Protest notices will be posted on the Official Notice Board at the Information Table. Protests will be heard at 1900 on Tuesday, August 7, 2019 at the James P. Muldoon River Center at St. Mary's College of Maryland. Note: It is every competitor's responsibility to check the Official Notice Board.

Awards:

Trophies will be awarded at the Awards Ceremony for the classes in which impending protests do not influence trophy results. Trophies will be awarded based on the number of registered boats in each class: 1st place (3 boats); 2nd place (5 boats); 3rd place (9 boats); 4th place (15 boats); 5th place (20 or more boats).
