

NOTICE OF RACE

- 1. **RULES**
 - 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2017-2020*.
 - 1.2. Boats shall comply with the rules and requirements of their respective class and/or measurement rules except as changed herein.
 - 1.3. The series is open to boats with a current YRA of LIS PHRF Certificate.
 - 1.4. Boats without a Current YRA of LIS PHRF Certificate filed with the race committee may participate but shall be scored DNC by the race committee without a hearing. This changes rules 63.1, A4.1, A5 & A9

2. DIVISIONS

2.1. Divisions shall be outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & FEES

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats owned by or under charter to members of IHYC, BYC, GBYC, OGYC, RYC and Catboats from Western LIS.
- 3.2. Each boat's entry and fee of \$25 must be submitted online by Tuesday July 24th. Entries shall be made at <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u>.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first division to start on July 27 will be at 1455. Remaining division will follow as signaled.
- 4.2. One race is scheduled for each division.
- 4.3. Races not completed on July 27 will not be re-sailed.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & SCRATCH SHEETS

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available beginning on or before July 27 from the Indian Harbor Yacht Club Front Desk; or online at www.yachtscoring.com; or from a Regatta Committee support boat before the start.
- 5.2. Scratch sheets showing each registered boat's starting division number may be obtained beginning 0900 Saturday, July 27 from the Indian Harbor Yacht Club Front Desk; or from a Regatta Committee support boat before the start; or online at www.yachtscoring.com; or from a Regatta Committee support boat before the start.

6. VENUE & COURSES

- 6.1. The starting line will be set approximately 1/8 n.m. SE of the IHYC Mooring field, located inside Captain Harbor, Greenwich, CT.
- 6.2. Courses and distances will be pre-determined and described in detail in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6.3. The finish will be the same as the start line.

7. SCORING

7.1. PHRF boat divisions will be scored using the "time-on-time" method, and the distance racing handicap issued to the boat by the YRA of LIS. The Catboat division will be scored as a one-design fleet.

8. POST-RACE GET-TOGETHER

8.1. All competitors are invited to Indian Harbor Yacht Club after their finish for a post-race party and awards. Temporary moorings and launch service are available for visiting yachts. Contact the IHYC Marine staff on VHF 68 or at the contact info listed below.

9. **PRIZES**

9.1. First, second, and third place prizes will be awarded in each division at the post race gathering

As a condition precedent to his or her participation in any race or series sponsored by Indian Harbor Yacht Club, Incorporated, including without limitation all activities associated with the event, each participant or competitor agrees to be bound by The Racing Rules of Sailing and by all other rules that govern this Regatta, and to participate entirely on his or her own responsibility, and waives any and all claims, including without limitation any claim in respect to assistance given or not given, against Indian Harbor Yacht Club, Incorporated, and the directors, officers, members, guests and employees of the Club, for any injury or damage resulting from such participation.
