

Florida State Snipe Championships Snipes & Windmills ST. PETERSBURG YACHT CLUB November 2-3, 2019

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 In case of conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.
- 2. ADVERTISING: The regatta is classified as Category "C"
- 3. ELIGIBILITY: The regatta is open to boats of the International Snipe Class and the Windmill Class.

## 4. ENTRY:

4.1 \$80 Entry fee includes two days racing and dinner for 2 at SPYC on Saturday. Extra dinner tickets may be purchased for \$25

4.2 Ten paid entries must be received by 1700 October 25 for a regatta.

A late fee of \$20.00 will be required after that date.

- 6. VENUE: Boats may be launched from SPSC on Demen's Landing, 250 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue SE. The racing area will be on Tampa Bay east of the St. Petersburg Pier.
- 7. COURSES: The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

## 8. SCORING:

- 8.1 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will be used.
- 8.2 One race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 8.3 There will be a throw out if five or more races are completed.

#### 9. PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded to the Skippers and crew placing First, Second, and Third in each Class. Special recognition for Boat Decoration and Treasure Hunt Winner

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
