## Amendment #1 to the NOTICE OF RACE

## **DELETE NOR 4.4 and REPLACE with the following:**

4.4 **HPR:** Entry is open to all HPR-style yachts as follows:

- a. HPR trophies will be awarded to HPR-style boats based on corrected seconds per mile as defined in the NOR.
- b. HPR boats will not have their own start and may enter in either PHRF or IRC. Entrants must conform to the class rules of the class they enter, including crew weights and sails.
- c. For rating purposes, the HPR base crew weight will be used for each boat's certificate.
- d. An HPR boat must have either a Valid or Introductory HPR certificate issued by the US Sailing Offshore Office. Introductory certificates are free of charge for this regatta; however, owners must confirm their configuration and may be required to obtain additional measurements if needed. For this regatta, where the Offshore Office has no history of VCG measurement, it may accept designer VCG and or flotation data at its discretion.
- e. A signed copy of the HPR certificate, signed by the person in charge, must be carried on board.

All HPR-style yachts that are compliant with paragraph 4.4(d) of this Amendment will be scored HPR unless they notify the NYYC Sailing Office in writing before the start of Race 1 of their preference not to be scored HPR. Complete measurement data must be submitted to the US Sailing Offshore Office by 1600 on 11-July-2014.
